After that you have to walk five hundred meters into the forest to get to the waterfall, which is 70 meters high. At the base of the waterfall there is a "natural pool" where we can swim in the fresh water of La Fortuna river for about one hour.</p> <p>The length of the tour is approximately four hours; from La Fortuna we have to go 5 ½ kilometers to the southeast. Our adventure takes us on the old path that Don Tobias went along, who was a well known horse breeder in the area.
